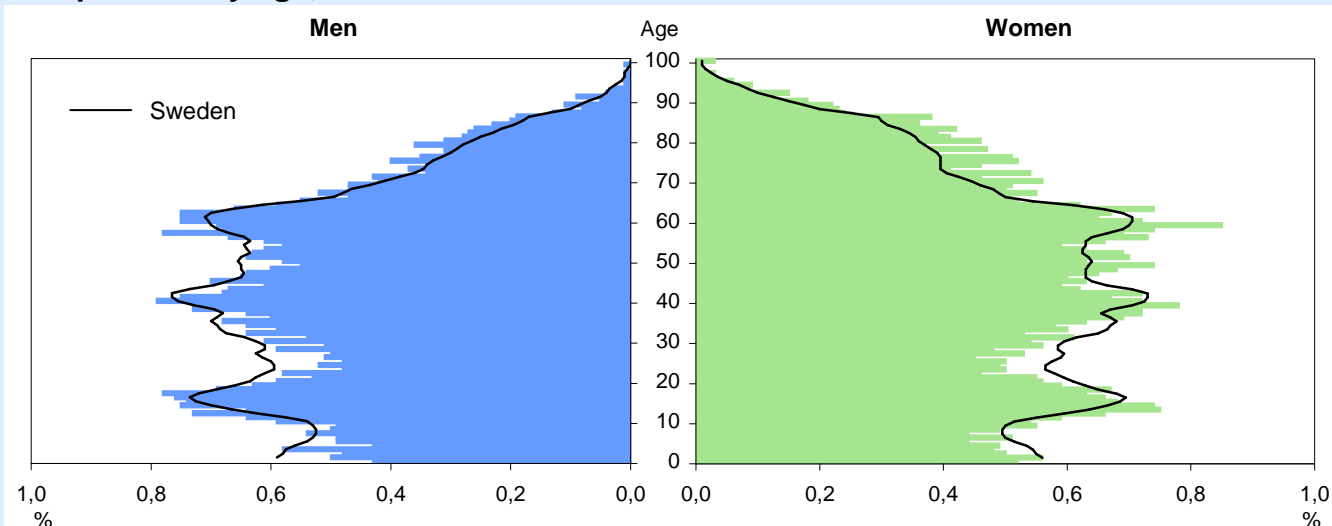

Population by age, 2006



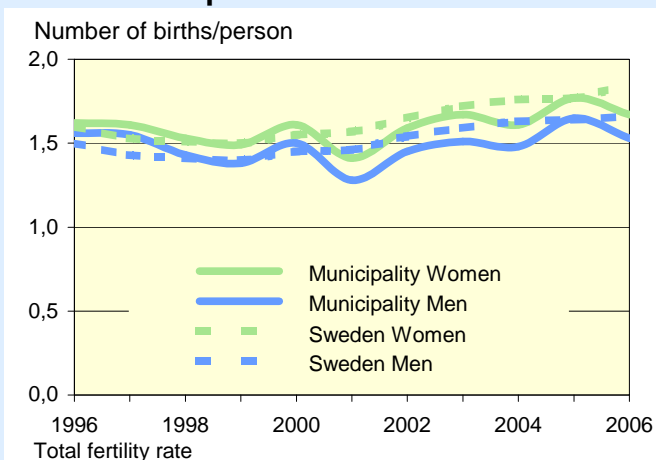

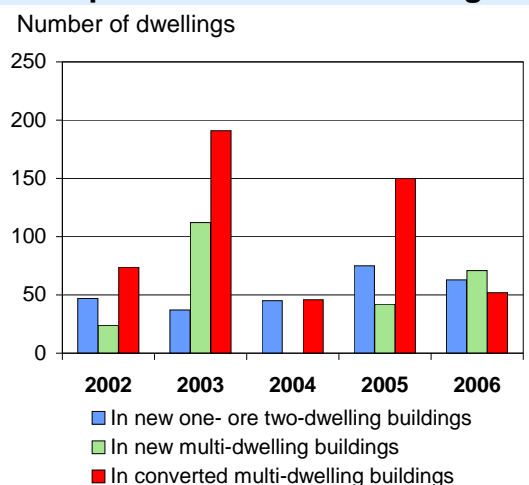

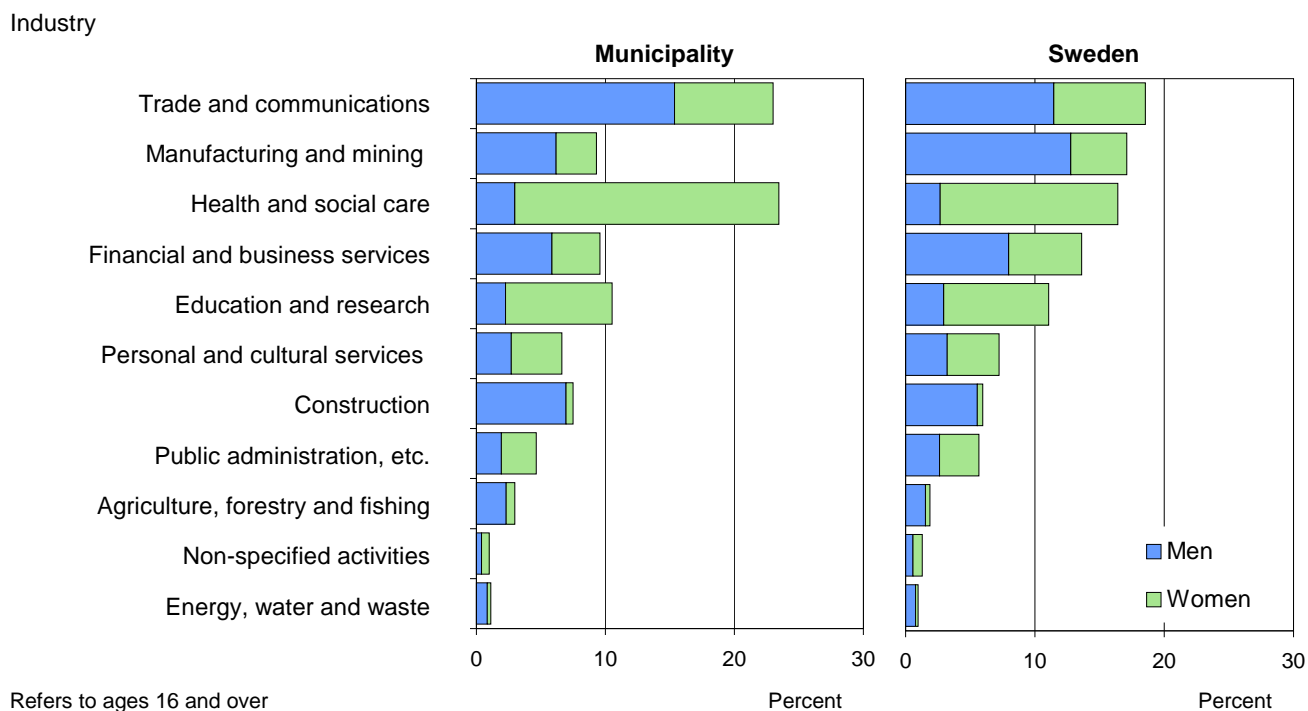

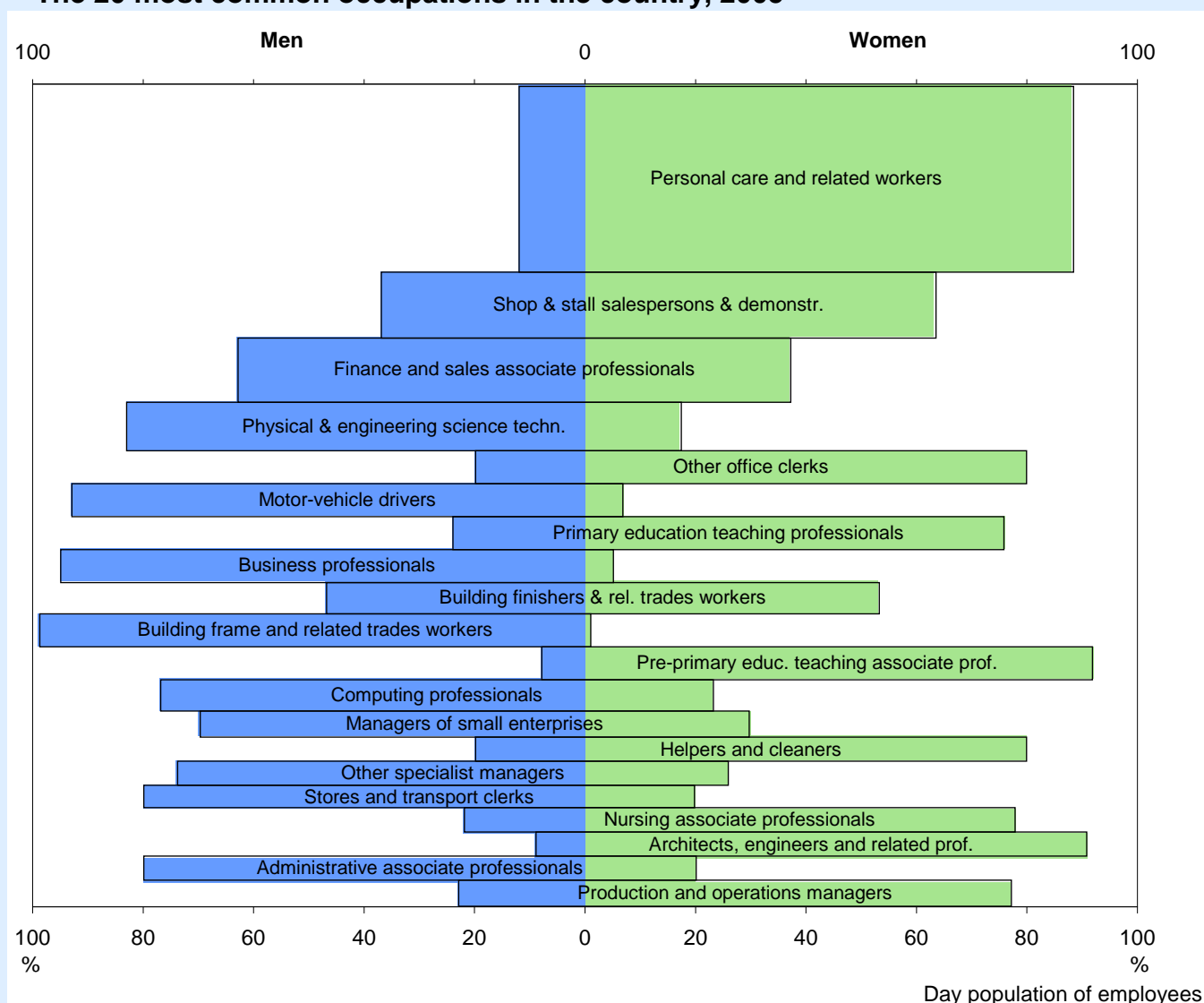

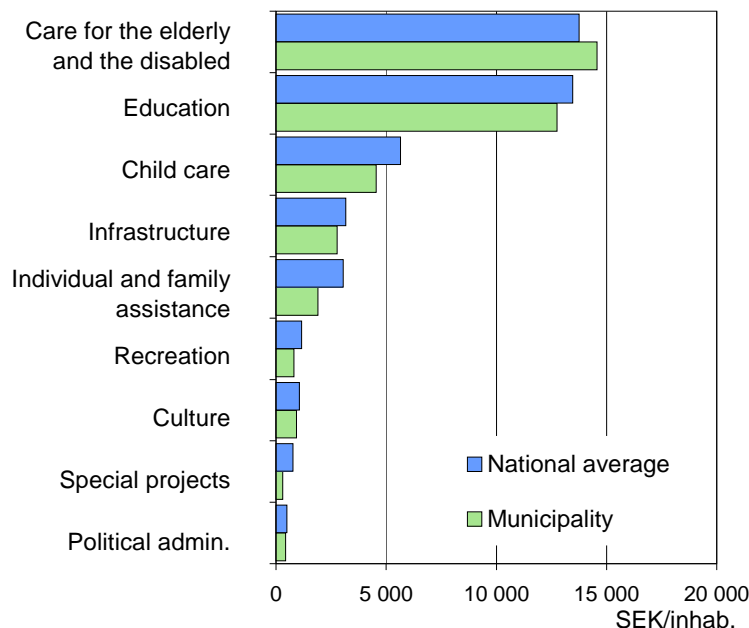
